in Oncology

The Nurse Practitioner in Oncology works in the hospital with patients admitted for cancer treatment, treatment-related complications, and supportive care for the management of their cancer.

The Nurse Practitioner in Oncology works closely with physicians, nurses, pharmacists, physical and occupational therapists, dietitians, social workers and Community Care Access Center case managers to assess and plan for patient care.

The Nurse Practitioner in Oncology performs physical examinations, interprets test results, prescribes treatments, and monitors the response to treatment.

The Nurse Practitioner in Oncology provides follow up visits in outpatient cancer clinics and ensures a smooth transition from outpatient to inpatient when necessary.
